

QUICK REFERENCE SHEET

TN Promise, Tennessee HOPE Scholarship & TN Scholars

Tennessee Promise:

- Offers 2 years of tuition-free community or technical college to high school grads
- NO GPA, ACT, or income requirements
- Students must apply online at www.tnpromise.gov by November 1, 2024
- Attend mandatory meetings
- Complete FAFSA by March 15, 2023
- Complete and report 8 hours of community service on the TNAchieves website
- If a student misses any deadlines, they are automatically ineligible for Tennessee Promise Scholarship

Tennessee Hope Scholarship

- Award Amount:
 - Four-year institutions
 - Up to \$4,500 per year for Freshman and Sophomores
 - Up to \$5,700 per year for Juniors and Seniors
 - Two-year institutions
 - Up to \$3,200 per year for Freshman and Sophomores
- Students must have a minimum of 21 ACT OR overall GPA of 3.0
- No income requirements
- Students must enroll within 16 months of high school graduation at an eligible institution
- Must complete FAFSA to qualify for HOPE
- General Assembly Merit Scholarship (supplement to Hope)
 - Up to \$1,000 per year
 - Student must have a minimum of a 29 ACT and overall GPA of 3.75

Tennessee Scholars

- Recognition program that involves community business leaders to help motivate all students to complete a rigorous course of study that will prepare them for college and careers. Sponsored by the Lebanon Wilson County Chamber of Commerce
- Medallion worn at graduation
- Gold seal on diploma
- Local, state, and national recognition (NOT A SCHOLARSHIP)
- Must complete 80 hours of community service over the course of high school
- No out of school suspensions and 95% attendance required
